What Good Can Come From a Rattlesnake?

God can do the same thing. He used a persecutor of His church, Saul of Tarsus, to spread His message to the Gentiles and in turn grow the very church Saul had earlier tried to destroy. He also used a cross, an object of death and punishment, to save His children from eternal death and punishment.

We must remember that God can use anyone and anything He chooses to accomplish what He wants. Let's remember that the next time we are tempted to think, "God cannot use what I have to offer."
